Dear Apartment Residents,

As we continue to assess the COVID-19 situation in our area, the potential case on our campus and the potential risk of exposure to the rest of our campus, we have made the decision effective tonight (Friday, 3/13) to deliver all dinner meals to all apartment residents who are on a meal plan. For those residents who have a shelf outside your apartment door, please clear that shelf off for meal delivery. If you wish to have something other than the first entrée listed on your menu for any day, please call your dining room before 11 am that day to request an alternate entrée.

Many leading health authorities are asking that at risk individuals (such as our residents) self-quarantine at this time to reduce any chance of exposure to this virus in our community. As such, we are requesting the following:

- Residents remain in their apartments, self-quarantining. You may still go get your mail if you are feeling well (no signs of illness), but please wash your hands thoroughly before and after each time you leave your apartment (at least 20 seconds with soap and water).
- Only one person be in the laundry room at a time. Before and after you use a laundry room, thoroughly wash your hands. If you show signs of illness, please refrain from using the laundry room.
- Limit visitors to your apartment to only **essential visitors** (such as caregivers or family dropping off groceries or supplies). If these visitors enter your apartment, require them to thoroughly wash their hands as soon as they enter your apartment.
- Turn away any person who attempts to visit (even essential visitors, caregivers) who has any signs of fever, cough or sore throat or has been exposed to someone with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19.
- If you begin to exhibit any signs of fever, cough or sore throat, please do not leave your apartment until you contact your doctor for further instructions.

Thank you for your cooperation and understanding. We are working very hard to keep you safe and more changes could be announced as we continue to monitor the situation and stay in compliance with leading health authorities and many other local, state and national authorities.
