Dear Apartment Residents,

As expected, things continue to change quickly in our community and as health authority, local, state and federal guidelines continue to change. As such, we are putting the following into effect in the Independent Apartments effective immediately.

- We ask you to not leave campus and to remain predominantly in your apartments, unless medically necessary to leave. For other types of appointments, we encourage you to do them over the phone if possible or postpone them until we are through this crisis. We ask that you have necessary supplies delivered, rather than leaving campus to get them.
- We suggest one person in the laundry room at a time, and it's okay to go and get your mail, as long as you are not feeling ill. Wash your hands thoroughly any time you leave and come back to your apartment.
- NO VISITORS other than critically essential visitors, such as care-givers assisting with medically necessary tasks, or for quick door to door delivery of critical supplies. Any critically necessary visitor should be free from all signs of illness, wash their hands upon entering your apartment, only enter if necessary to provide critical care and not linger in any public area of the building.
- Caregivers providing non-medically essential tasks (such as laundry, bed linen changes and additional housekeeping) should cease. If you are unable to do your own bed-linen changes and laundry, you can contract this through Living Care housekeeping services. You can call 965-5260 during regular business hours to set this up.
- The courtesy car will only be available for medically necessary appointments.
- We will not be taking any guest apartment reservations.
- The Village Café will continue to be available for meal deliveries if you cannot get groceries and we may be able to provide some other supplies through this service in the future as we find it necessary. We will keep you posted on updates as things progress.
