If you are following the news, you'll know that Yakima County has the highest rate of infection of any county in the state of WA and over 60% of COVID-19 deaths in our state are linked to long term care facilities. As such, we must stay diligent to keep this virus off of our campus! Please remember that it is possible for individuals to be infected with this virus and spreading it to others, even if they have no symptoms. We screen staff and approved caregivers daily, but there is still risk that grows exponentially with every additional person that comes onto our campus.

With the beautiful weather we've been experiencing lately, we have been noticing more and more visitors coming onto campus despite our "no visitor" signage and policy. We know how hard it is to be separated from your loved ones. Staff are also grieving separation from our families and normal activities. However, we must continue to be diligent and enforce this policy to keep all of you and our staff safe, and to keep this campus COVID-19 free. Some visits we have witnessed were using masks and honoring social distancing, but these visits are unfortunately still not allowed on our campus at this time.

As such, we find the need to remind you:

Visitors are not allowed on campus at this time.

This includes inside apartments, on patios, & on the pathway or other walkways.

Families may still drop off sanitized items (like as groceries and supplies) to the white folding tables in your foyers, or outside your apartment doors in Cook and Senior View.

We encourage all of you to stay in contact with your loved ones over the phone, video chats or other ways. We also encourage you to interact safely with other residents out on the pathway (wearing a mask and keeping 6 feet of distance between each person).

Let us reiterate again that we know how hard this is. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation as we work together to keep us all safe.
