We can celebrate another week with no COVID-19 cases on our campus! Unfortunately, Yakima County is still being hard hit by the virus. About 20% of the total county cases and deaths occurred just in the past week. As such, we continue to stay diligent to keep this virus off of our campus.

The Living Care management team is starting to very cautiously discuss what types of small activities, and in what format, we may be able to safely offer in the coming weeks. We recognize how difficult isolation is, and also the physical decline that happens with reduced opportunities to exercise. We do not have finalized plans yet. At whatever point in time we start any such activities, there will be small steps and management will continually assess the safety of such activities. We will likely have a screening process prior to participating in activities, and also likely only allow residents to participate who have not been off campus or had contact with someone from off campus in the 14 days prior.

We know that another concern from residents is when the salon will open. We still plan to open the hair salons in Living View as soon as we are allowed to with the Governor's phasing. We will have new processes and protocols for salon use which we will publish as we get closer to opening.
