Dear Residents,

We are all so eager for Yakima County to reach Phase 2 of the Governor's 4 phased county opening plan. Unfortunately, we are still experiencing large daily increases in our confirmed COVID-19 cases in our county. According to the Yakima Health District, as of this morning our county has just shy of 5,000 confirmed cases, 96 deaths and 48 people currently hospitalized. We all, myself included, are so eager to start resuming normal daily operations, but the consequences of opening our campus too early could be devastating. As always, I thank you and your families for your patience and cooperation during this difficult season.

I do have some good news! Our "Chatter Box" will be opening for visits starting this coming Friday, June 12th! We are using an online scheduling system for these visits and the link to sign up for a visit will be posted on our website at www.livingcarecommunity.com/covid-19. For residents and their families who do not have internet access to schedule a visit, please call the Resident Services office for assistance. We currently have timeslots available for the month of June (weekdays only) and will add July time slots at a later date. We are going to ask that families coordinate together and initially schedule just one visit for the month of June to allow other residents and their families a chance to coordinate and schedule a visit. We are also going to limit the visits to a maximum of 5 family members at a time. When families arrive for their scheduled visit time, we are asking that they remain in their car until the time their visit was scheduled to start. Residents should arrive approximately 5 minutes before your scheduled visit time. Staff will be present to help get you situated inside the Chatter Box and to welcome your family.

This week you received a daily lunch special menu from the Café. Starting this week, the café will be offering a new lunch special each day for just \$5.29 + tax. I would encourage you to call the café at 853-3080 to learn more about these specials and take advantage of them.

Those of you who have expressed interest in some of our upcoming *small* group activities will be receiving communication from our Activities Director, Jennifer Vimont, soon regarding these. Please be patient with us as we endeavor to start providing activities while adhering to strict sanitation protocol and a limit of only 5 residents per activity at a time.
