Dear Residents,

I'm pleased to let you know that starting Monday, August 24th, you will be able to visit with loved ones on our grounds (outside of the buildings). Please note that we are requesting a maximum of 2 visitors at a time per resident or resident couple. Visitors are welcome to bring lawn chairs. You may still schedule visits utilizing the Chatterbox with up to 5 visitors.

For your protection, and that of others around you, please consider the following before inviting guests onto our campus:

- Are your guests feeling well with no current symptoms of illness?
- Do your guests work in the community in a profession that puts them at high risk for contracting and carrying the Coronavirus (they could be asymptomatic)?
- Do your guests practice good social distancing and wear a mask when in public spaces?
- Will your guests be respectful of social distancing while on campus and not approach other residents that they may encounter on our campus? (Other residents may not want to be approached and may still want to maintain good distance from others.)

Some recommended spots for your visits:

- Gable View – Under the gable on the 40th Avenue side of the building
- At the Rose Garden at the end of the Pioneer Pathway near Summitview
- Under the new gazebo along the pathway at the end of Senior View & Cook
- Living View – at the NW entrance to the building at the bistro table
- Living Court – in the uncovered seating area outside the front entrance

Please refrain from gathering with visitors in front of the Village Center and around the Chatterbox out of respect for those still utilizing this contact free method of visiting. Please also refrain from bringing guests into the raised garden bed areas.

Please note that with opening up the grounds, Living Care will not be able to sanitize every chair or bench regularly so we encourage you to be very careful about hand washing, not touching your face, wearing a mask and social distancing. Enjoy visiting safely.
