Dear Residents,

I am happy to report to you that our campus COVID cases are under control at this time. Most of our Healthcare Center residents are now on the mend and we have no known active cases in our Assisted Living or Independent Living Apartments. As of today, it's been 2 weeks since our last Gable View resident tested positive for COVID. We are so thankful for this! However, we will still continue to use extra care especially in this building until a little more time goes by without any new cases. Although things seem to be under control now on our campus, the community as a whole is still experiencing large numbers of new COVID cases. As such, we need to continue to stay vigilant campus wide.

On Tue. Dec. 8th, Gov. Inslee extended our current statewide restrictions until Jan. 4th. This extension is especially hard during the holiday season. Some of the highlights of this guidance are:

- Indoor social gatherings with people outside of your household are prohibited.
- Restaurants and bars are closed for indoor service.
- Fitness facilities and gyms must close for indoor operations.
- Wedding and funeral receptions are prohibited.
- In-store retail, including grocery stores, are limited to 25% occupancy.
- Long-term care facilities can only offer outdoor visits. There are exceptions for end-of-life care.

Given our current COVID status in the county, recent exposures on campus, the above guidance and the simple truth that our campus houses a high-risk population, we will continue to keep our campus fairly closed throughout the month of December and re-evaluate in January.

We are still offering the following services to help you limit your exposures off campus:

- Grocery pick-up at Wrays only. Orders turned in by noon Monday are picked up on Tuesday.
- Prescription pick-up. Kindly give us as much notice as possible for these pick-ups.
- Shipping services, via the Yakima Shipping Shop only.
- Courtesy car service for medically necessary appointments.

While this season of lock-down in our community is difficult, we hope to provide lots of small tokens of cheer throughout the coming weeks to provide moments of laughter and seasonal joy.
